1st day :: Arrival to Split port ::

If You are coming by airplane we will organize the transfer from the airport Split for You. If You are arriving on Your own we will meet in front of a catamaran for the island of Korčula. After arriving in Korčula Town we will inform You about a programme and make arrangements for the next day.

2nd day :: Korčula – town of Marko Polo ::

We will see the sights of Korčula Town led by a local guide during afternoon, visit it reach treasuries... After lunch on a nearby island we will visit Korčula Archipelago by boat, set ashore of the islets Vrnik, Badija, Stupe "intruding" upon their solitude a little...

Hiking: 2 h - easy

3rd day :: Dubrovnik –Town of Monuments::

Firstly by ferry and then by minibus we will reach Dubrovnik. Led by a local guide we look around this jewel of Croatia, best known for its well-preserved historic centre, its terracotta rooftops, and a stunning location overlooking the Adriatic. We will have lunch in a local restaurant and afterwards continue with sightseeing tour enjoying in Town's delightful beauties walking on its 13th-century city walls...

4th day :: Pelješac Peninsula ::

The boat will carry us over the Pelješac Channel to the village of Kućište on the Pelješac Peninsula. The path will lead us over the southern hillsides through abandoned vineyards to the monastery of Holy Virgin Mary's Assumption, in which the Maritime Museum is located, and which offers a spectacular view over the whole Pelješac and the Korčula Riviera. After lunch we will continue through villages to Orebić.

Hiking: 3.30 h – easy

5th day :: Mljet National Park ::

This day is scheduled for visit to the green and the unspoilt Mljet National Park on the island of the same name. The boat will take us to Pomena bay, from which we will continue on foot to the two interconnected saltwater lakes - Veliko Jezero and Malo Jezero and belvedere Montokuc, enjoy a spectacular tidal shift under Mali most which connects the lakes, travel by boat to the centre of the larger lake to the exquisite St Mary's Island crowned by a Benedictine Monastery...

Lunch – a picnic near the lakes.

Climb: 220 m

Coming down: 220 m

Hiking: 3 - 4 h - easy to medium difficult

6th day :: "Defora" tour ::

On this day we will visit three picturesque bays, Bratinja Luka, Pavja Luka and Orlanduša – commonly called Defora. The allure of swimming into deeply cut bays with beautiful beaches and crystal-clear sea is simply irresistible. We will have lunch on a homestead.

Climb: 320 m

Coming down: 320 m

Hiking: 5 h – medium difficult

7th day :: Kočje ::

Transfer to the village of Pupnat. Hiking through famous Pupnat vineyards and further to the region Kočje, which will give us insight into completely different island world. We will continue through the village of Žrnovo to Korčula Town, make a short village stroll, and have a swim if You want.

Climb: 250 m

Coming down: 250 m

Hiking: 3.30 h.

8th day :: Transfer by boat to Split ::

Return home. If You came by an airplane we will organize the transfer to the airport.
